



Become a Land Trust Volunteer

St. Simons Land Trust has an ongoing need for volunteers to help us carry out our work. With a variety of different volunteer needs, there are opportunities for all ages, skills and interests. The general categories of Stewardship, Administration and Special Events are described below.



Stewardship

Stewardship volunteers help the Land Trust maintain our properties through specific projects, such as building trails or planting trees, or regular property cleanup through our Adopt-A-Property Program. You may also become a Trail Ranger for the John Gilbert Nature Trail.



Administrative

Administrative volunteers help prepare letters, invitations, newsletters and more for our mailings. Help is generally needed during the weekdays, and some people take sections of the mailing home to complete. With the volume of letters that we mail annually, there is always a great need for administrative help.



Special Events

Our largest special event, with the greatest volunteer need, is our annual Oyster Roast. Volunteers help with food and drink donations, party supplies, table centerpieces, event publicity, event set-up, bartending, cleanup and more. The Land Trust also has a booth at local environmental fairs and fundraisers, including the Department of Natural Resources' annual Coast Fest and the Georgia Sea Turtle Center's annual Nest Fest.



Special Skills
